








QUESTIONS FOR *Growth Group*

-  What stands out to you about this passage? Is there a word, character, response or event that grabs your attention?
-  Do you have any questions that might help you gain clarity of the passage such as historical context, language, characters, references, etc?
-  What does this passage reveal about God? What does it communicate about God's character, His love, or His mission?
-  What does this passage reveal about you, the church, or the human condition?
-  What truth from this passage can you connect to your life today?
-  In light of what we have talked about today, how can this group be praying for you?
-  Who outside of the church can you encourage by sharing a biblical truth/attribute of God/application point that you discussed today?

Quick Guide:

- Use a study Bible (the notes contain an abundance of insights).
- Pray before you read, asking the Holy Spirit to teach you and guide you through His Word.
- Read the passage before your Growth Group and write your reflections down.
- Bring your reflections and questions to your group time and engage in the conversation.
- Listen to the sermon on Sunday.
- Read trusted commentaries to answer any questions you may still have.
