



GUIDELINES FOR LEVEL 4 GATHERINGS @ FPC ON & OFF CAMPUS

GROUP SIZE & CONTACT TRACING

Group size is determined by the size of the space and the county's current risk level/tier on California's Blueprint for a Safer Economy.

Everyone must be able to maintain physical distancing requirements in the gathering space.

For each tier there is a maximum room capacity percentage as well as maximum group size.

Page 2 contains the chart with specific FPC room capacities at each of the colored tiers.

Group includes attendees, guests, volunteers and leaders.

MAINTAIN APPROPRIATE PHYSICAL DISTANCING

Maintain 6 feet of distance from others; especially once settled. Avoid physical contact such as hugs & handshakes. Attendees living in the same household do not need to physically distance.

SCREEN HEALTH OF PARTICIPANTS

We ask you not to attend if you or anyone in your household:

- has a fever, cough, or recent loss of sense of taste/smell;
- has been exposed to COVID-19 within two weeks of event;
- is waiting for COVID-19 test results.

WEAR MASKS

Masks that closely cover both nose and mouth are required at all times for indoor events. At outdoor events masks are required while entering, exiting, or moving around the event. They may be removed once seated with proper physical distancing, unless otherwise instructed by the leader.

Masks are required while singing and when moving about. Worship leaders can remove masks while singing, but must meet County & State guidelines of at least 15' distance.

PRACTICE GOOD HYGIENE

Leaders and hosts will ensure adequate sanitation before, during, and after each event.

At a minimum sanitation will include hand sanitizer and cleaning of anticipated touch points.

Monitor the flow of restroom use to help prevent overcrowding of small spaces.

Attendees are encouraged to wash their hands and/or use hand sanitizer.

FOOD DO'S AND DON'TS

DO: Recommend attendees bring their own food & drinks and refrain from sharing. Serve individual portions & food in single-serve containers. Food preparers and servers must wash hands, wear gloves and be masked. Maintain physical distance in food prep & service.

DON'T: Offer self-service food or beverage with common serving utensils/vessels that multiple people touch. Hold pot-lucks or family-style eating/drinking that risk cross-contamination.
Pass food or beverages (including communion) among attendees.
